1. Call to Order at 7:04 pm.
2. Approval of Agenda: Kate Lalley moved to approve; seconded by Steven Antinozzi
3. Approval of January Meeting minutes: Added to minutes a discussion regarding a group forming for future work on the LaPlatte Pedestrian Bridge. Paths Committee members involved include Joplin James, Kevin Boehmcke, and Steven Antinozzi along with other interested residents. Motion to approve with change by Kevin B. seconded by Jeff.
4. Public Comment: No public comments.
5. Library Site Plan: Jeff Zweber disclosed he is part of the Engineering firm working on the project. He explained there are 5 separate parcels coming together as a PUD which raises the stormwater requirements. Kate asked if the site plan was to include the entire complex. It does not. Discussion around stormwater area moved north closer to the library. Kate stressed the importance of the aesthetics of this area and offered her assistance as a Landscape Architect if one is not involved in this project. Plans now show the crosswalk at the north Shelburne Road entrance moved toward Shelburne Road. The Paths Committee believes it is safer for pedestrians if the crosswalk is set back from the road. It is the hope of the Committee

that the sidewalk along the entire Town Offices complex be set back in the future.

6. Comprehensive Plan Update: Kate directed the discussion of the transportation section of the Comprehensive Plan. Members are asked to review the rest of the Transportation Section prior to the March meeting.
7. Development review: Sterling Construction (AKA Coleman) project. Wendy reported that she and Kate attended the SNRCC meeting. The committee agrees it is important for the developer to construct a sidewalk along Irish Hill Road along the width of the project.
8. Updates : LaPlatte Pedestrian Bridge: The original design has changed. Private funds (\$12,000) have been raised with the possibility that the total may increase to \$18,000.

Membership status: Wendy said Steven, Chris and Kevin's terms are up April 2018 and she hopes they will renew their membership on the Committee. The Chair position is to be reviewed annually. Wendy requests another Paths member to become Chair. Also we are seeking a student member. Wendy and Kevin will reach out to their contacts at CVU.

9. Adjourn: Motion by Kevin to adjourn. Kate seconded. Meeting adjourned at 9:30pm.
