**Call to Order**

The meeting was called to Order by Chair Kevin Boehmcke at 6:36 PM.

**Identification of note taker**

**Approval of Agenda**

Kevin suggested addition of an item relating to Caroline Weaver's research relating to possible bikeshare deployment in Chittenden County. The agenda was approved as revised.

**Approval of Minutes**

Upon motion by Kate Lalley, the minutes for October 15 were approved.

**Public Comment**

Kevin mentioned the discovery of Steve Rocco Antinozzi's membership status (had expired and been overlooked) and his decision not to seek reappointment. Wendy, recognizing the benefits of having members from various neighborhoods, suggested that an effort be made to find a resident of the Hullcrest area to serve on the committee. Effort will be made to have Shelburne News publish an item regarding the vacancy.

**BPPC items in budget**

Dean and Kevin provided the group with an update relating to the presentation made to the Selectboard at the budget session held on December. There was a brief discussion of the committee's annual funding allocation (for expenses such as attending conferences) and potential projects relating to wayfinding.

### Irish Hill Road sidewalk/bridge project

Dean provided an update on the status of the Irish Hill Road sidewalk/bridge project. He suggested that Sai Sarapelli of CCRPC be invited to attend an upcoming meeting. He explained Sai might play a role in management of the project for the Town. Dean will contact Sai and report back to the group.

### Comprehensive Plan

Dean provided an update on the status of the Comprehensive Plan. The first Selectboard hearing on the Plan will take place on January 22. There was a brief discussion of maps as well.

### LaPlatte Suspension Bridge

Joplin James provided an update on the LaPlatte Suspension Bridge. There was additional discussion of fund raising and related topics.

### Sharing/Coordination with VPSG

Jane Zenaty participated in a discussion relating to coordination between the BPPC and the VPSG (Village pedestrian safety group), which for the present time will remain an independent committee. Jane also described the budget request she presented to the Selectboard on behalf of the VPSG.

### Climate Economy program

Dean described the opportunity Shelburne has to seek selection as a Vermont Council on Rural Development (VCRD) "Climate Economy" Model Community. The deadline for submitting a proposal is January 18, 2019. One core component of the program is "transportation systems improvement." BPPC members expressed interest in supporting but not leading the effort.

The next meeting of the BPPC will take place on January 21<sup>st</sup>, which is Martin Luther King day.
