- a. Bridge inspection (Joplin Wistar)

 - iii. Solution needed for netting along the bridge.
- b. Maps Update
 - i. Maps awaiting design, looking to identify a resource with skills and software.
 - ii. Joplin wondering if marking private property is necessary. Committee voiced consensus that it is not necessary.
- c. Site visit for LaPlatte Circle access trail upgrade
