

Shelburne Veterans Committee Meeting

April 5, 2021

Veterans Monument

Present: Sam Feitelberg, Colleen Haag, Bud Ockert, Paul Goodrich, Pete Gadue, Jim Donaldson and new member Henry Harder. Not present Eric Hanley.

The meeting opened at 5:05 p.m. by current Chair Sam Feitelberg. Sam stated that he had stepped down as Chair but will continue as an Emeritus and will continue to attend meetings. Henry Harder was welcomed to the committee.

REORGANIZATION: Pete Gadue nominated Jim Donaldson for Chairman who declined. Paul Goodrich nominated Bud Ockert, seconded by Henry "Hank" Harder and unanimously elected Chairman of the Committee.

He has also been in touch with Rick Neu who is a Lutheran minister. He also asked the group about Louis Hanlon who has offered to sing since the Shelburne School Orchestra will not be able to attend. Bud has spoken to Gail Feitelberg about the three women who have previously sang at one of our events. Colleen will contact .. Kris Engstrom about the wreath. Colleen and Bud will work on the program.

Bud talked about his challenge with the Shelburne News. He stated Front Porch Forum is better to get the word out.

Pete stated a new flag was needed and he would take care of obtaining it. He also stated he was appointed by the Governor to a military committee.

Discussion ensued about this year's Shelburne Market. It will not be held at the Town Green but rather at Dave Palmer's sugarhouse property on Shelburne Hinesburg road. There was no consensus as to whether we would have a veteran's table there.

It was determined that Dave Hall would again take care of the initial maintenance.
