1. **Harbor Place: \$1000 grant approved** to help pay for meals/individual containers prepared by volunteers for Harbor Place/Days Inn guests.
2. **Agewell: \$3000 grant approved** for volunteer support, food and production of grab and go meals.
3. **VT Family Network: \$1000 grant approved** to help fund the Family Support Program.
4. **Ascension Childcare: \$1000 grant approved** to help purchase social/emotional support tools for classrooms.
