March 14th Selectboard Meeting has agenda item for paving Falls Rd, Harbor Rd and Rt 7 intersection. ARPA Discussion on what they might want from 250K

4. Trail Updates - Andrew gave an update on the South access trail from Kwiniaska Ridge to trails. Boulder Hill HOA pushed back and wanted the trail entirely on Kwini land. Boulder Hill HOA and Kwini HOA are going to try to forge a compromise.
5. MAPS Group Report Out - Sharing of Final Product and Rollout Plans.
  - a. Nicole will work with Betty to get the map linked to from Rec Dept and BPPC sites. We will also promote it on Shelburne News and FPF. We may add a feedback form on the map for feedback on the map itself.
6. Shelburne Bike Ped Master Plan - Charlie
  - a. The Shelburne Alternative Transportation Plan is supposed to be updated every 5 years. If a subset of the Comprehensive Plan it may be every 8 years going forward.
  - b. Can we put together a grander more comprehensive vision? Broader goals. i.e. linking safe routes to school, linking neighborhoods together, linking better to surrounding towns. Evaluate and use data and metrics to create plans that can feed 2027 Comprehensive Plan update.
7. FY22-23 Fund Status and Next Steps - \$45K to spend by the end of June. Meant for any

pedestrian safety project the town deems necessary. Get quote from Paul Goodrich for Bay Rd from boat launch to Shelburne Farms to widen road. Paul indicated that town right of way would allow similar work from Shelburne Farms down Harbor Rd to school sidewalks.
