OLD BUSINESS

1. Plan for Community Fund reimbursements to Police: Officers can now give out emergency funds knowing that Social Services will reimburse them. It will be validated, Sue will be contacted and she will fill out the request for a reimbursement check, checks will be written from the Community Fund. Funding will be limited up to \$200 per incident.
2. 2022-23 Grant Recipients to date: 7 from General Fund, one from Community Fund

1. Lund Application: \$3000 grant approved to contribute towards programs which help low income families break cycles of poverty, addiction and abuse. Lori will draft a call for volunteers on FPF.

4. Outreach Adding New Agencies to List: discussion reviewed 28 named agencies who have received grants in the past 3 years. Several new possible recipients were mentioned including ANEW Place, Lakeview Cooperative Inc. and an LGBTQ Center.
