Shelburne Town Beach Rules and Regulations

- 1) The town beach is open from sunrise to sunset. Lifeguards are on duty from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Lifeguards will be performing other duties from 10:00 – 11:00 AM and 6:00 – 7:00 PM, so if there is an emergency, you can notify one of them to call Shelburne Rescue.
- 2) A beach pass is required for park use. Only residents of Shelburne may purchase beach passes. Cost for the season pass is \$30.00 for the first vehicle. Additional vehicles passes within a household are \$10.00 each. Season passes for senior citizens (60 or older) are \$15.00 per vehicle. Day Passes are available to Shelburne residents at \$10.00 per day. Guests of Shelburne Residents may obtain a pass for \$10.00 per vehicle per day (resident must be present to bring in a guest).
- 3) Parking is limited to authorized areas only. A current beach pass must be displayed at all times and should be affixed to the front, driver’s side bumper or a day pass on the front dashboard. No parking in boat access area or turn around area.
- 4) Swimming is allowed in areas marked by buoys only. No Swimming the in the boat launch area.
- 5) No bottles, glass, or flip-top cans in beach area.
- 6) The Beach facility is a “haul it in-haul it out” facility. Please remove your own garbage. **NO LITTERING!**
- 7) **NO FLOTATION** devices allowed except for Coast Guard approved life jackets.
- 8) An adult must accompany children under 12 years of age.
- 9) Alcohol is prohibited in all areas of the park.
- 10) Dogs and other pets are prohibited from the entire beach and park facility **at all times.**
- 11) Boats, sailboards, and/or motorized crafts are not permitted near swim area as per boating regulations, which are posted at boating area. Paddleboards may be launched from the beach area outside of swim ropes.
- 12) Open fires are not permitted.
- 13) Firearms and/or explosives are prohibited.
- 14) Beach supervisor on duty will have final authority on safe swimming conditions.
- 15) No nudity is allowed.
- 16) No overt or excessive displays of affection are allowed.
- 17) Infractions of the above regulations will be dealt with by the beach supervisor on duty.
- 18) Please, no playing in the CLAY.

These Beach Rules apply to everyone at all times!
